AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at the State Farm.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hun-
6 dred and five, to wit:—

7 For the payment of salaries at the state farm,
8 a sum not exceeding fifty-seven thousand dollars.

(Appropriation 1904, \$51,000.)

10 For current expenses at the state farm, includ-
11 ing printing the annual report of said institution,
12 a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty-five
13 thousand and two hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
14 chap. 85; Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$151,200.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
