AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Medfield Insane Asylum.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of two hundred and
2 thirty-five thousand six hundred and ninety-three
3 dollars and thirteen cents is hereby appropriated,
4 to be paid out of the treasury of the Common-
5 wealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the sup-
6 port of the Medfield insane asylum during the
7 present year, said sum being based upon the aver-
8 age number of state patients at the rate of two
9 dollars and eighty cents per week, as provided for
10 by sections one hundred and twenty-seven and
11 one hundred and twenty-eight of chapter eighty-
12 seven of the Revised Laws, to include printing
13 and binding the annual report, this amount to be
14 in addition to the receipts from other sources; and
15 so much of said receipts as may be needed to pay

16 the expenses of the institution may be used for
17 that purpose. [Rev. Laws, chap. 87, sect. 6;
