AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Sharon to renew Certain Bonds and to make an Additional Water Loan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Sharon is hereby
2 authorized to issue bonds, notes or scrip, to be
3 denominated on the face thereof, "Sharon Water
4 Loan," to the amount of twenty thousand dollars,
5 to take up and retire the bonds originally issued
6 by the Sharon Water Company, the payment of
7 which the town assumed when it purchased the
8 franchise, corporate property, rights, powers and
9 privileges of the Sharon Water Company under
10 the provisions of chapter two hundred and forty-
11 one of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
12 ninety-four.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Sharon for the pur-
2 poses mentioned in chapter two hundred and

3 forty-one of the acts of the year eighteen hun-
4 dred and ninety-four, and for the further exten-
5 sion and improvement of its water supply system,
6 may issue in addition to the issue of bonds, notes
7 or scrip provided for in section one of this act,
8 bonds, notes or scrip from time to time, to be
9 denominated on the face thereof, "Sharon Water
10 Loan," to an amount not exceeding twenty thou-
11 sand dollars: *provided*, that no source of water
12 supply for domestic purposes shall be taken under
13 this act without the consent of the state board of
14 health, and that the location of all drains, reser-
15 voirs and wells shall be subject to the approval of
16 said board.

1 SECTION 3. The issue of any bonds, notes or
2 scrip under the act shall be in addition to the
3 amounts hereinbefore authorized by law to be
4 issued by said town, and any bonds, notes or scrip
5 issued under this act shall be issued upon the
6 same terms and conditions, and with the same
7 powers, as are provided in said chapter two hun-
8 dred and forty-one of the acts of the year eighteen
9 hundred and ninety-four, for the issue of the
10 Sharon Water Loan by said town.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
