AN ACT

To authorize the Metropolitan Park Commission to take Certain Lands in the Town of Randolph.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commis-
2 sion, constituted under chapter four hundred and
3 seven of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
4 and ninety-three, without the concurrence of any
5 other board or commission, may take in fee or
6 otherwise, by purchase, gift, devise or eminent
7 domain, in the name and for the benefit of the
8 Commonwealth, as a public reservation for exer-
9 cise and recreation, lands and rights in lands in
10 the town of Randolph, as an addition to and in
11 improvement of lands devised to the Common-
12 wealth through said commission by the late Henry
13 L. Pierce. Said commission shall have the same
14 powers of management and control of the prop-
15 erty acquired under this act as is conferred on it

16 by chapter four hundred and seven of the acts of
17 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three and
18 acts in addition thereto and in amendment thereof
19 in respect to other lands hitherto acquired by it.

1 SECTION 2. The damages sustained by any
2 person or corporation by reason of any taking
3 hereunder shall be recovered in the manner pro-
4 vided in section seven of said chapter four hun-
5 dred and seven.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
