### AN ACT

To regulate the Shooting of Wild Ducks and Geese  
in Certain Waters of the County of Dukes County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful in the county  
2 of Dukes county for any person to shoot or kill  
3 wild ducks or geese in any fresh-water pond from  
4 a boat, raft or other device situated at a greater  
5 distance than fifty yards from the shore.

1 SECTION 2. Any person violating any pro-  
2 vision of this act shall be punished by a fine of  
3 not less than five nor more than two hundred and  
4 fifty dollars.
