

HOUSE No. 1201.

Bill accompanying the petition of H. Clifford Gallagher for legislation to incorporate the Milton Savings Bank. Banks and Banking. April 26.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Milton Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. H. Clifford Gallagher, Samuel
2 Gannett, Ellerton P. Whitney, Francis R. Hart,
3 Charles E. Rogerson, Robert F. Herrick, J.
4 Porter Holmes, Charles S. Pierce, Hiram Tuell,
5 William H. Fitzpatrick and Nathaniel H. Stone,
6 their associates and successors, are hereby made
7 a corporation by the name of the Milton Savings
8 Bank, with authority to establish and maintain a
9 savings bank in the town of Milton, with all

10 powers and privileges, and subject to all the
11 duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all
12 general laws now or hereafter in force relating to
13 savings banks and institutions for savings.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
