RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Repairs and Improvements at the Grafton Colony of the Worcester Insane Asylum.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 twenty-five thousand dollars, to be expended under the
4 direction of the trustees of the Worcester insane asylum,
5 for the further development of the Grafton Colony, as
6 follows: For a bridge over the Boston and Albany track,
7 a sum not exceeding seven thousand dollars; for laundry
8 machinery, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars;
9 for roadways for the approaches to the proposed bridge
10 and for road machinery, a sum not exceeding fifteen
11 hundred dollars; for machinery for carpenter shop, a
12 sum not exceeding two thousand dollars; for repair of
13 buildings, addition to the sewerage system and extension
14 of water mains, a sum not exceeding thirty-two hundred
15 dollars; for fencing, a sum not exceeding sixteen hun-
16 dred dollars; for ovens for bakery and bread-mixer,
17 fifteen hundred dollars; for fire hose and extinguishers,
18 two thousand dollars; for extension of telephone lines,
19 a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars; additional
20 out-buildings, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars;
21 and for carriages, a sum not exceeding four hundred
22 dollars.
