## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

### AN ACT

Relative to Assessments upon Cities and Towns in  
the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Park  
Districts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In case any apportionment for  
2 assessment upon the cities and towns of either  
3 the metropolitan water, sewerage or park districts  
4 shall not have been finally determined by July  
5 first of any year, the last apportionment thereof  
6 shall remain in force for the purpose of assess-  
7 ment during such current year. Any difference  
8 between such apportionment when finally made  
9 by the commission, for such year, and the pre-  
10 existing apportionment above referred to, shall  
11 be adjusted with such city or town by the treas-  
12 urer and receiver general in the assessment of  
13 the succeeding year by a deduction therefrom or

14 addition thereto, as may be required to give effect  
15 to the said apportionment when made, as afore-  
16 said.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
