RESOLVE

To extend the Time within which Report shall be made by the Commission appointed to prepare a Register of the Adult Blind and to investigate and report as to their Industrial Training.

1 *Resolved*, That the time within which the commission
2 appointed to prepare a complete register of the adult
3 blind and for other purposes, which was constituted by
4 chapter eighty-seven of the resolves of the year nineteen
5 hundred and four, is required to report to the general
6 court is hereby extended until the fifteenth day of Janu-
7 ary in the year nineteen hundred and six; and the chief
8 of the bureau of statistics of labor is hereby empowered
9 and instructed to aid the commission in its preparation
10 of a register of the adult blind by furnishing it, upon its
11 request, with the names, addresses and such other facts
12 concerning the adult blind as may be recorded by the
13 enumerators in taking the decennial census in the year
14 nineteen hundred and five.
