AN ACT

Relative to the Boston Police Relief Association.

Be it enucted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The Boston Police Relief Associa-

- 3 of said association that the benefit to accrue by
- 4 reason of the decease of members of the associa-
- 5 tion may be made payable to the wife, child by

- 9 vided, however, that when a benefit certificate has

- 11 ents of a member have died, or ceased to be so
- 12 dependent, then, with the approval of the officers
- 13 of the said association, and subject to such rules
- 14 as they may prescribe, any other person may be
- 15 named as beneficiary in the certificate.
 - 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its 2 passage.
