

SENATE No. 116.

To accompany the petition of Henry Parsons for legislation to authorize the renting of state armories for certain purposes. Military Affairs.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To authorize the Renting of State Armories for
Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In cities or towns where a state
2 armory is located, the company or companies of
3 the state militia occupying the same shall have
4 the privilege of renting said armory for such time
5 and for such entertainments as shall be approved
6 by the adjutant-general.

1 SECTION 2. The moneys received under the
2 provisions of section one of this act shall be paid
3 to the treasurer and receiver-general of the
4 Commonwealth and shall be credited to the
5 armory fund.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
