## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### RESOLVE

To authorize the Louisiana Purchase Exposition Managers for Massachusetts to dispose of Certain Furniture belonging to the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the Louisiana Purchase Exposition  
2 managers for Massachusetts are hereby authorized to sell  
3 at public auction during the Lewis and Clark exposition  
4 to be held at Portland, in the state of Oregon, the whole  
5 or any part of the furniture belonging to the Common-  
6 wealth which has been loaned by the Commonwealth to  
7 said managers. The furniture which is to be so sold is not  
8 to be delivered until after the close of the Lewis and  
9 Clark exposition and the proceeds of such sale may be  
10 used by said managers for such purposes as may be  
11 approved by the governor and council.
