Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

RESOLVE

To authorize the Chief of the Bureau of Statistics of Labor to furnish to the Commander of the Massachusetts Department of the Grand Army of the Republic the Names and Addresses of Persons who served in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps of the United States during the War of the Rebellion.

1 *Resolved*, That the chief of the bureau of statistics
2 of labor is hereby authorized and instructed to furnish
3 to the commander of the Massachusetts department of
4 the Grand Army of the Republic the names and ad-
5 dresses of all persons who served in the army, navy or
6 marine corps of the United States during the war of the
7 rebellion, so far as such names and addresses may be
8 recorded by the enumerators in taking the decennial
9 census in the year nineteen hundred and five; and that,
10 for the purpose of paying the expenses which may be
11 incurred in carrying out the provisions of this resolve,
12 there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the
13 Commonwealth a sum not exceeding one thousand
14 dollars.
