AN ACT

Relative to the Taking of Quahaugs in the Towns
of Orleans and Eastham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section six of chapter two hun-
2 dred and sixty-nine of the acts of the year nine-
3 teen hundred and four is hereby amended by
4 adding at the end of said section the words:—
5 *and nothing herein contained shall be construed to*
6 *affect the rights of the inhabitants of Orleans and*
7 *Eastham under section five of chapter sixty-four*
8 *of the acts of the year seventeen hundred and*
9 *ninety-six, approved March three, seventeen hun-*
10 *dred and ninety-seven,—so as to read as follows:—*

11 *Section 6.* So much of section eighty-five of
12 chapter ninety-one of the Revised Laws as is in-
13 consistent herewith shall not apply to the said
14 towns; *and nothing herein contained shall be*

15 *construed to affect the rights of the inhabitants*
16 *of Orleans and Eastham under section five of*
17 *chapter sixty-four of the acts of the year seven-*
18 *teen hundred and ninety-six, approved March*
19 *three, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven.*

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
