I submit also a supplementary report filed in this office by the Chief of the Bureau of Statistics of Labor, making a correction in the enumeration of the population and legal voters in the town of Concord, Middlesex County.

DEAR SIR:—I desire to submit, in connection with the census of 1905, a report supplementary to the one filed by me in your department on the first day of December.

An enumerator in the town of Concord, county of Middlesex, who had failed to file his bill of services, brought it in, after repeated requests, on the 16th inst. At the same time he delivered to the Bureau a package of census cards which he had collected, but which he had failed to send in with his work. As the 45 persons reported were living in Concord on the first day of May, 1905, an addition should be made to the population of that town.

I submit herewith the additions required to make the census report complete, and this will be the final statement as regards the population and legal voters.
