### AN ACT

Relative to Fines Imposed for Offences against the Laws concerning Automobiles and Motor Cycles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All fines imposed by any court or trial  
2 justice under the provisions of chapter four hundred and  
3 seventy-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and three  
4 or any other act relative to automobiles or motor cycles  
5 shall inure to the benefit of the Commonwealth. The  
6 fines shall be paid monthly by the courts or trial justices  
7 into the treasury of the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. The treasurer and receiver general shall  
2 apply the money so received to any appropriation for  
3 the repair of state highways, to be expended by the  
4 Massachusetts Highway Commission.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
