AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Department of the Auditor of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the eleven months
5 ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen
6 hundred and six, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the auditor, thirty-two hun-
8 dred eight dollars and thirty-three cents. [Rev.
9 Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14; Acts 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$3,500.)

10 For the salary of the first clerk in the auditor's
11 department, twenty-two hundred ninety-one dol-
12 lars and sixty-six cents. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6,
13 sect. 14; Acts 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$2,500.)

14 For the salary of the second clerk in the

15 auditor's department, two thousand sixteen dollars
16 and sixty-six cents. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14;
17 Acts 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$2,400.)

18 For the salaries of the extra clerks in the
19 auditor's department, fifty-five hundred dollars.
20 [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14; Acts 1905, chap.
21 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$6,000.)

22 For stenographers and such additional clerical
23 assistance as the auditor may find necessary for
24 the proper dispatch of public business, a sum not
25 exceeding forty-one hundred and twenty-five dol-
26 lars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14; Acts 1902,
27 chap. 177; 1902, chap. 120; 1905, chap. 211.]

28 For the salary of the messenger in the auditor's
29 department, eight hundred and twenty-five dol-
30 lars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14; Acts 1905,
31 chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$900.)

32 For the compensation of a state printing expert,
33 a sum not exceeding thirteen hundred and seventy-
34 five dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 18; Acts
35 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$1,500.)

36 For incidental and contingent expenses in the
37 department of the auditor, a sum not exceeding
38 thirteen hundred and seventy-five dollars. [Rev.
39 Laws, chap. 6, sect. 25; Acts 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$1,500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
