AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Publication of a Record of Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors who Served in the War of the Rebellion.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ninety-one hundred
2 sixty-six dollars and sixty-six cents is hereby ap-
3 propriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for
5 expenses in connection with the publication of a
6 record of Massachusetts troops and officers, sail-
7 ors and marines, in the war of the rebellion, as
8 authorized by chapter four hundred and seventy-
9 five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
10 ninety-nine.

Appropriation 1905, \$10,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
