Bill accompanying the petition of John Bascom and another for legislation to authorize the expenditure of a sum of money from the treasury of the Commonwealth by the Greylock Reservation Commission for the purpose of acquiring additional land. Harbors and Public Lands. January 10.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To provide for Enlarging the Greylock State Reservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding thirty thousand dol-
2 lars may be paid out of the treasury of the Common-
3 wealth from the ordinary revenue, to the Greylock reser-
4 vation commission, to be expended by the commission
5 for the purpose of acquiring, by purchase or otherwise,
6 such lands adjoining the present Greylock state reserva-
7 tion or enclosed by it as the commission may deem it
8 necessary or advisable to acquire.

1 SECTION 2. Said commission shall have the same
2 powers to acquire, take and care for such additional lands

3 as are given to it by section four of chapter five hundred
4 and forty-three of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
5 and ninety-eight in respect to the lands already acquired
6 by the commission for the said reservation. The addi-
7 tional land so taken or acquired shall form a part of the
8 said reservation, and the title thereto shall be and remain
9 in the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. The necessary expense for care and main-
2 tenance of the additional lands so taken or acquired shall
3 be paid by the county of Berkshire in the manner pro-
4 vided in section five of said chapter five hundred and
5 forty-three.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
