### AN ACT

Relative to the Sittings of the Second District Court of Southern Worcester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Sittings of the Second District Court of  
2 Southern Worcester for criminal business shall hereafter  
3 be held at Uxbridge daily, except on Sundays and legal  
4 holidays.

5 Sittings of said court for the transaction of civil busi-  
6 ness shall hereafter be held at Uxbridge as required by  
7 law and on such other days as may be fixed by rule of  
8 the court.

9 Sittings of said court now required to be held at  
10 Blackstone are hereby abolished.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
