Bill accompanying the petition of F. P. Royce, vice-president, for legislation to authorize the Springfield Gas Light Company to furnish gas for heat, light and power in the town of Ludlow. Public Lighting. January 19.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To authorize the Springfield Gas Light Company to do
Business in the Town of Ludlow.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Springfield Gas Light Company
2 is hereby authorized, upon the approval of the selectmen
3 of the town of Ludlow and of the Board of Gas and
4 Electric Light Commissioners to carry on the business
5 of furnishing gas for heat, light and power in the town
6 of Ludlow, with all the rights, powers and privileges,
7 and subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions
8 set forth in the general laws now or hereafter in force
9 applicable to such corporations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
