In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To provide for ascertaining the Opinion of the Voters as to the Election of United States Senators by Direct Vote.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The secretary of the Commonwealth shall,
2 prior to the next state election, cause to be placed
3 upon the official ballot the following words:—
4 Is it expedient that the general court should re-
5 quest the congress of the United States to call a
6 convention for the purpose of proposing an
7 amendment to the constitution of the
8 United States so as to provide for the
9 election of United States senators by direct vote
10 of the people?
