Bill accompanying the petition of George H. Jackson and others for legislation to amend the law relative to the recount of votes cast at elections. Election Laws. January 23.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To amend the Law relating to the Recount of Votes of Elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That section two hundred and sixty-
2 seven of chapter eleven of the Revised Laws be and
3 hereby is amended by striking out, beginning at line
4 thirty, the words "may appear and be present during
5 such recount either in person or by an agent appointed
6 by him in writing," and substitute therefor the follow-
7 ing:— shall be allowed to be present and witness such
8 recount either in person or by an agent appointed by
9 him in writing.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
