## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

### AN ACT

Relative to the American Humane Education Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of directors of the American  
2 Humane Education Society, a corporation established by  
3 chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the acts of the  
4 year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, may from time  
5 to time vest in and place under the control of such trust-  
6 tee or trustees as they may appoint, any part of the  
7 funds or other property of the corporation to be held  
8 subject to any trusts affecting the same, and otherwise  
9 upon such terms and conditions as the directors may  
10 prescribe.

1 SECTION 2. The organization of said corporation and  
2 the title of its officers are hereby ratified and confirmed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
