

SENATE No. 6.

To accompany the petition of Edward H. Keith, mayor, for legislation relative to the rate of taxation in the city of Brockton. Cities.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

Relative to the Rate of Taxation in the City of
Brockton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seventy-one
2 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and four
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in the eighth
4 and ninth lines, the words "thirteen dollars in the
5 year nineteen hundred and six," and inserting in
6 place thereof the words:— fifteen dollars in the
7 years nineteen hundred and six, nineteen hundred
8 and seven, nineteen hundred and eight, nineteen
9 hundred and nine and nineteen hundred and ten, —
10 so as to read as follows:—*Section 1.* The taxes

11 assessed on property in the city of Brockton, ex-
12 clusive of the state tax, county tax and sums
13 required by law to be raised on account of the
14 city debt, shall not exceed, on every one thousand
15 dollars of the assessors' valuation of the taxable
16 property therein for the preceding year, fifteen
17 dollars in the year nineteen hundred and four,
18 fourteen dollars in the year nineteen hundred and
19 five, and fifteen dollars in the years nineteen
20 hundred and six, nineteen hundred and seven,
21 nineteen hundred and eight, nineteen hundred and
22 nine and nineteen hundred and ten; the said valu-
23 ation being first reduced by the amount of all
24 abatements thereon previous to the thirty-first
25 day of December in the year preceding said
26 assessments, subject to all the provisions contained
27 in section fifty-four of chapter twelve of the
28 Revised Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
