AN ACT

To exempt from Taxation Certain Real and Personal Property belonging to the Estate of Esther C. Mack, deceased.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. So much of the real and personal  
2 property of the estate of Esther C. Mack, de-  
3 ceased, late of Salem, as was devised by her last  
4 will, duly proved and allowed by the probate  
5 court for the county of Essex, on the twenty-sixth  
6 day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-five,  
7 to Alfred Stone as trustee for the purpose of

8 establishing an industrial school, in said Salem,  
9 shall be exempt from taxation so long as the  
10 income thereof is devoted to the support and  
11 maintenance of the Esther C. Mack industrial  
12 school or any similar institution in accordance  
13 with the requirements of said will.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
