

SENATE No. 49.

To accompany the petition of Fordis C. Parker for legislation relative to the distribution of fees and fines imposed upon owners or operators of motor vehicles. Roads and Bridges.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

Relative to the Distribution of the Fees of Fines and Penalties imposed upon Owners or Operators of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter four hun-
2 dred and seventy-three of the acts of the year nine-
3 teen hundred and three is hereby amended by in-
4 serting after the word "Commonwealth," in the
5 sixth line of said section the following words:—
6 And any unexpended balance thereof shall be added
7 to the amount appropriated for the maintenance or
8 construction of state highways by the Massachu-

9 setts highway commission, — so as to read as fol-
10 lows: —

11 *Section 12.* The fees received under the provisions
12 of this act shall be paid monthly by the secretary
13 of the highway commission into the treasury of the
14 Commonwealth; and such expenses as may be neces-
15 sary in carrying out the provisions of this act shall
16 be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth;
17 and any unexpended balance thereof shall be added
18 to the amount appropriated for the maintenance or
19 construction of state highways by the Massachu-
20 setts highway commission.

1 SECTION 2. All fines and penalties paid under the
2 provisions of section five of chapter three hundred
3 and eleven of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
4 and five, shall be paid into the treasury of the
5 Commonwealth, and the same shall be expended by
6 or under the direction of the Massachusetts high-
7 way commission for the maintenance or construc-
8 tion of highways.

1 SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed: *provided, however,*
3 that nothing herein contained shall be so construed
4 as to effect the disposition, as now authorized by
5 law, of fines recovered for violations of rules and
6 regulations established by boards of park commis-
7 sioners for the government of lands, roadways and
8 boulevards under their care or for violations of
9 laws of the Commonwealth within the limits of such
10 lands, roadways or boulevards.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
