To accompany the petition of George W. Buck for legislation to authorize insurance companies incorporated for that purpose to insure against loss due to the explosion of fly-wheels. Insurance.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To authorize Insurance Companies Incorporated for that Purpose to insure Against Loss Due to the Explosion of Fly-wheels.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 That clause fourth of section twenty-nine of
2 chapter one hundred and eighteen of the Revised
3 Laws of nineteen hundred and two be and it
4 hereby is amended by adding at the foot thereof
5 the words: — or fly-wheels, — so that said clause
6 shall read as follows: —

7 *Fourth.* To insure against loss or damage to
8 property of the assured, or loss or damage to the
9 life, person or property of another for which the
10 assured is liable, caused by the explosion of steam
11 boilers or fly-wheels.
