

SENATE No. 193.

To accompany the petition of Edward L. Logan for legislation to regulate the tenure of office of certain officers of the militia. Military Affairs.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

AN ACT

To regulate the Tenure of Office of Certain Officers of the Militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The term of office of a brigadier
2 general of the line shall be for three years and he
3 shall be ineligible for re-election.

1 SECTION 2. The term of office for a colonel of
2 a regiment shall be for five years and he shall be
3 ineligible for re-election.

1 SECTION 3. The term of office for other field
2 officers shall be for seven years and they shall be
3 ineligible for re-election.

1 SECTION 4. Any officer named in sections one,
2 two and three of this act who shall serve the full
3 time allowed by this act, shall, upon his own re-
4 quest, be placed upon the retired list with the rank
5 next above that held by him at the time of the
6 making of said request.

1 SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
