RESOLVE

In favor of Henry T. Mangan.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Henry T. Mangan of
3 Lowell the sum of one hundred dollars, in full com-
4 pensation for expenses incurred for veterinary services
6 for, and for the loss of, a horse necessarily killed in con-
7 sequence of injuries received while used in the line of
8 duty by a member of the State militia.
