AN ACT

Relative to Additional Clerical Assistance in the Office
of the Tax Commissioner.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter fourteen of
2 the Revised Laws, as amended by chapter ninety-
3 nine of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
4 four, is hereby further amended by striking out
5 the word "nineteen," in the seventh line, and
6 inserting in place thereof the word:—twenty-
7 two,—so as to read as follows:—

8 Section 2. He shall appoint a deputy at a
9 salary of twenty-five hundred dollars a year, and
10 may employ two permanent clerks, the first at a

11 salary of two thousand dollars a year and the
12 second at a salary of fifteen hundred dollars a
13 year, and such additional clerical and other assist-
14 ance as may be necessary at an expense not ex-
15 ceeding twenty-two thousand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
