RESOLVE

To authorize the Treasurer and Receiver General to borrow
Money in Anticipation of Revenue.

1 *Resolved*, That, in anticipation of the receipts of the
2 present year, the treasurer and receiver general is hereby
3 authorized to borrow, at any time before the expiration
4 of fifteen days after the meeting of the next general
5 court, such sums of money as may from time to time be
6 necessary for the payment of ordinary demands on the
7 treasury, at such rates of interest as shall be found neces-
8 sary; and that he shall repay any sums borrowed under
9 this resolve as soon as money sufficient for the purpose,
10 and not otherwise appropriated, is received into the
11 treasury.
