### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Construction of a  
Stone Breakwater off the Town of Revere.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ten thousand dollars is  
2 hereby appropriated to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the construction of a stone breakwater off the  
5 town of Revere, as authorized by chapter ninety-  
6 nine of the resolves of the year nineteen hundred  
7 and six, the same to be in addition to any amount  
8 heretofore appropriated for the same purpose.

(No appropriation 1906.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
