Bill accompanying the petition of Charles C. Hutchinson for legislation to provide for reimbursing certain savings banks for taxes paid on real estate used for banking purposes. Banks and Banking. January 15.

AN ACT

To provide for Refunding Certain Taxes Assessed
Against Savings Banks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any savings bank which has paid to
2 the Commonwealth a tax on its real estate used for
3 banking purposes or on any part of its deposits in-
4 vested in real estate used for banking purposes
5 shall be reimbursed therefor from the treasury of
6 the Commonwealth to the amount so paid, upon ap-
7 plication to the auditor of the Commonwealth; and
8 the said auditor on satisfactory proof that the tax
9 was paid, shall certify the account to the governor
10 and council in the same manner as other claims
11 against the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
