

HOUSE No. 287.

Bill accompanying the petition of Frank J. Tuttle and others for legislation to establish the salaries of clerks and assistant clerks of district, police and municipal courts. Public Service. January 16.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the Clerks and Assistant Clerks of District, Police and Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of each dis-
2 trict, police and municipal court, other than the
3 municipal court of the city of Boston, is hereby es-
4 tablished at three-quarters of the salary of the
5 justice thereof; and the salary of an assistant clerk
6 of any such court at three-quarters of the salary of
7 the clerk thereof.

1 SECTION 2. So much of this act as reduces the
2 salary of any clerk, or assistant clerk of a district,
3 police or municipal court, shall not take effect while
4 the present incumbent continues to hold office.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.
