

Bill accompanying the petition of Frank W. Goodwin and another for legislation to regulate the sale of alcohol by druggists. Public Health. January 17.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

AN ACT

To regulate the Sale of Pure Alcohol by Druggists and Apothecaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred of
2 the Revised Laws is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the word "apothecaries," in the first line,
4 the words:—*having a sixth-class license or a cer-*
5 *tificate of fitness,*— and by inserting after the word
6 "purposes," in the second line, the words:—
7 *without a physician's prescription, the said sales to*
8 *be recorded in manner provided for in section*
9 *twenty-six of chapter one hundred,*— so as to read
10 as follows:—*Section 21. Druggists and apothecaries*
11 *having a sixth-class license or a certificate*
12 *of fitness may sell pure alcohol for medicinal, me-*
13 *chanical or chemical purposes without a physician's*
14 *prescription, the said sales to be recorded in the*
15 *manner provided for in section twenty-six of chap-*
16 *ter one hundred.*
