Bill accompanying the petition of Richard O. Coughlin for legislation to regulate the restraining and killing of unlicensed dogs. Agriculture. January 21.

AN ACT

To better Protect the Public in Respect to Unrestrained
Dogs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The various boards of county com-
2 missioners may appoint a dog officer, at a rate of
3 compensation to be by them determined, who shall
4 exercise supervision within the respective county
5 limits, of unrestrained and unmuzzled dogs.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
