## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

### AN ACT

To increase the Enlisted Strength and Allowance of Horses for Field Artillery in the Militia.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-nine of chapter four  
2 hundred and sixty-five of the acts of the year nine-  
3 teen hundred and five is hereby amended by striking  
4 out all after the word "than," in the third line,  
5 down to and including the word "artillery," in the  
6 fourth line, and inserting in place thereof the  
7 word:—sixty-five;—by striking out the word  
8 "eighty-five," in the tenth line, and inserting in  
9 place thereof the words:—one hundred and four,—  
10 as each battery is equipped with the new material.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
