AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the State Colony for the Insane.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, unless
4 otherwise ordered, for the maintenance of the
5 state colony for the insane during the fiscal year
6 ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen
7 hundred and seven, to wit:—

8 From the receipts of said colony for the insane
9 now in the treasury of the Commonwealth, the sum
10 of eleven hundred fourteen dollars and thirty-one
11 cents, and from the treasury of the Commonwealth
12 a sum in addition not exceeding eighty-three thou-
13 sand eight hundred eighty-five dollars and sixty-nine
14 cents. [Acts 1905, chaps. 175 and 211.]

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
