Resolve accompanying the petition of Howard Fulton Butler for legislation to provide for suitable medals for Massachusetts soldiers and sailors who were in the service of the United States during the war of the rebellion or the war with Spain. Military Affairs. January 23.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

RESOLVE

To provide for Suitable Medals for Certain Veterans of the War of the Rebellion and the War with Spain.

1 *Resolved*, That a commission, to serve without pay,
2 consisting of the lieutenant governor, adjutant general
3 and a third person to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby authorized and directed to procure suitable bronze
5 medals for each soldier and sailor who served during the
6 war of the rebellion or during the war with Spain, and
7 who, at the time of his enlistment, was a legal resident of
8 Massachusetts, and who was either honorably discharged
9 from or died in the service. The adjutant general shall
10 deliver the medals on application to such persons as he
11 may deem entitled to receive the same.
