Bill accompanying the petition of George A. Schofield for legislation to enable the town of Ipswich to appropriate a sum of money for the widow and children of George H. Gilmore. Towns. January 23.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Ipswich to pay a Sum of Money to the Widow of George H. Gilmore.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Ipswich is hereby authorized
2 to pay a sum not exceeding dollars to the
3 widow and children of George H. Gilmore, who lost his
4 life while in the performance of his duty as a member
5 of the Ipswich fire department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
