AN ACT

To provide for an Additional Stenographer in the
Detective Department of the District Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The chief of the district police may
2 appoint an additional stenographer for service in
3 the detective department of the district police, at a
4 salary not exceeding one thousand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect December
2 first, nineteen hundred and seven.
