AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Reading to make an Additional
Water Loan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Reading, for the purposes
2 mentioned in section six of chapter four hundred and
3 five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
4 nine, may issue bonds, notes or scrip, to be denominated
5 on the face thereof, Reading Water Loan, to an amount
6 not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars in addition to
7 the amount heretofore authorized by law to be issued by
8 said town for the same purpose.

1 SECTION 2. At the time of authorizing said loan, the
2 town shall provide by vote for the payment thereof in
3 annual payments of one thousand dollars each, beginning
4 in the year nineteen hundred and eight; and when a vote
5 to this effect has been passed, the amount required thereby
6 shall without further vote be assessed by the assessors of

7 said town in each year thereof, in the same manner as
8 other taxes are assessed under the provisions of section
9 thirty-seven of chapter twelve of the Revised Laws, until
10 the debt incurred by said loan is extinguished.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
