### AN ACT

Relative to the Registration of Carriers of Intoxicating  
Liquors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section forty-nine of chapter one  
2 hundred of the Revised Laws is hereby amended  
3 by inserting after the word "business," in the  
4 sixth line, the words:— *and to no other person or*  
5 *corporation,*— by inserting after the word "con-  
6 tained," in the ninth line, the words:— *No person*  
7 *or corporation not regularly and lawfully conduct-*  
8 *ing a general express business shall receive such*  
9 *liquors for transportation for hire or reward for*  
10 *delivery in a city or town, in which licenses of the*  
11 *first five classes are not granted nor transport or*  
12 *deliver such liquors in such cities or towns,*— and  
13 by striking out the words "or by any other per-  
14 son," in the twelfth line,— so as to read as fol-  
15 lows:— *Section 49. Spirituous or intoxicating*  
16 *liquor which is to be transported for hire or reward*

17 for delivery in a city or town in which licenses of  
18 the first five classes are not granted, shall be deliv-  
19 ered by the seller or consignor to a railroad corpo-  
20 ration or to a person or corporation regularly and  
21 lawfully conducting a general express business, *and*  
22 *to no other person or corporation*, in vessels or  
23 packages plainly and legibly marked on the outside  
24 with the name and address, by street and number,  
25 if there be such, of the seller or consignor, and of  
26 the purchaser or consignee, and with the kind and  
27 amount of liquor therein contained. *No person or*  
28 *corporation not regularly and lawfully conducting*  
29 *a general express business shall receive such liquors*  
30 *for transportation for hire or reward for delivery*  
31 *in a city or town in which licenses of the first five*  
32 *classes are not granted, nor transport or deliver*  
33 *such liquors in such cities or towns.* Delivery of  
34 such liquors or any part thereof by a railroad cor-  
35 poration, or by a person or corporation regularly  
36 and lawfully conducting a general express business  
37 to a person, other than the owner or consignee,  
38 whose name is marked by the seller or consignor  
39 on said vessels or packages, or at any other place  
40 than is thereon marked, shall be deemed to be a  
41 sale by any person making such delivery to such  
42 person in the place in which such delivery is made.

1 SECTION 2. Section four of chapter four hundred  
2 and twenty-one of the acts of the year nineteen  
3 hundred and six is hereby amended by striking out  
4 the words "the transportation of," in the sixth  
5 line thereof, so that said section will read as fol-  
6 lows:— *Section 4.* Any person violating the pro-  
7 visions of this act shall be punished by a fine of not

8 less than fifty dollars nor more than five hundred  
9 dollars, or by imprisonment for not less than one  
10 month nor more than six months, or by both such  
11 fine and imprisonment, and any violation of the  
12 laws relative to transportation, keeping or sale of  
13 intoxicating liquors, by a person holding a permit  
14 granted under authority hereof, shall render such  
15 permit void.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
