AN ACT

To extend the Time within which Certain Improvements may be made at Deacon's Pond in the town of Falmouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The time within which expenditures may
2 be made from the treasury of the Commonwealth for
3 improving Deacon's pond in the town of Falmouth, as
4 authorized by chapter four hundred and sixty-one of the
5 acts of the year nineteen hundred and six, is hereby ex-
6 tended for two years, so that twenty-five thousand dollars
7 may be expended in the years nineteen hundred and
8 seven, nineteen hundred and eight, or nineteen hundred
9 and nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
