

SENATE No. 63.

To accompany the petition of George B. Ager and others for the extension of the south metropolitan sewer through the Brighton district of the city of Boston to Waverley Place in the city of Newton. Metropolitan Affairs.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

AN ACT

To provide for an Extension of the South Metropolitan Sewer through the Brighton District of the City of Boston into the City of Newton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan water and sewer-
2 age board shall construct, maintain and operate as
3 part of the south metropolitan system of sewage
4 disposal, a sewer extending from Oak square in the
5 Brighton district of the city of Boston, through
6 Brighton and the city of Newton as far as Wash-
7 ington street at Waverley place in said city, sub-

8 stantially as outlined in the fourth annual report
9 of said board, and in part execution of the plan
10 outlined in said report.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of constructing and
2 maintaining this additional sewer, the metropolitan
3 water and sewerage board shall have and exercise
4 all the authority conferred upon the metropolitan
5 sewerage commissioners and their successors by
6 chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts
7 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and
8 acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto,
9 and all the provisions of said chapter and other
10 acts are hereby made applicable to this additional
11 construction, unless herein otherwise provided.

1 SECTION 3. To meet the expenses incurred under
2 the provisions of this act the treasurer and re-
3 ceiver general shall, with the approval of the gov-
4 ernor and council, issue from time to time bonds
5 in the name and behalf of the Commonwealth, and
6 under its seal, to an amount not exceeding eight
7 hundred thousand dollars. The provisions of sec-
8 tion fourteen of said chapter four hundred and
9 twenty-four and of all acts in amendment thereof
10 and in addition thereto relative to the indebtedness
11 authorized by and incurred under that chapter
12 shall, so far as they may be applicable, apply to
13 the indebtedness authorized by this act, in the same
14 manner as if the said provisions had been inserted
15 herein. Any premium realized on the sale of said
16 bonds shall be paid into the Metropolitan Sewerage
17 Loan Sinking Fund, South System.

1 SECTION 4. The interest and sinking fund re-
2 quirements on account of the moneys expended in
3 constructing the extension of the south metropoli-
4 tan sewer provided for in this act, and the cost and
5 maintenance thereof shall be deemed a part of the
6 interest and sinking fund requirements and costs
7 provided for in said chapter four hundred and
8 twenty-four, and shall be apportioned, assessed and
9 collected in the manner provided by that chapter
10 and by acts in amendment thereof and in addition
11 thereto.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
