Bill accompanying the petition of John S. Sheppard, Jr., for legislation to authorize the Alpha Theta Chapter of the Chi Psi Fraternity in Williams College to hold additional real estate. Mercantile Affairs. January 3.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the Alpha Theta Chapter of the Chi Psi Fraternity in Williams College to hold Additional Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter sixty-eight of
2 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "fifty," in the fifth
4 line thereof, and by inserting in place thereof the word:
5 — *seventy-five*, — so that the said section shall read as
6 follows:—

7 *Section 3.* The said corporation is authorized to re-
8 ceive, purchase, hold, mortgage and convey real and
9 personal property for the uses of said chapter: *provided*,
10 that the value of the real estate so held at any time shall
11 not exceed *seventy-five* thousand dollars, and that said
12 property shall not be exempt from taxation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
