## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Bureau of Statistics of Labor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the  
3 Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for  
4 the purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on  
5 the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred  
6 and eight, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the chief of the bureau of sta-  
8 tistics of labor, three thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws,  
9 chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$3,000.)

10 For the salary of the first clerk of the bureau of  
11 statistics of labor, two thousand dollars. [Rev.  
12 Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$2,000.)

13 For the salary of the second clerk of the bureau  
14 of statistics of labor, sixteen hundred and fifty  
15 dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$1,650.)

16 For the salaries of the two special agents of the  
17 bureau of statistics of labor, the sum of twenty-  
18 four hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$2,400.)

19 For such additional clerical assistance and for  
20 such expenses of the bureau of statistics of labor  
21 as may be necessary, a sum not exceeding twenty-  
22 five thousand and three hundred dollars. [Rev.  
23 Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$18,800.)

24 For expenses in connection with the annual col-  
25 lection of statistics of manufactures, a sum not ex-  
26 ceeding sixty-five hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,  
27 chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$6,500.)

28 For expenses in connection with taking a special  
29 census in towns having an increased resident popu-  
30 lation during the summer months, a sum not ex-  
31 ceeding one thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap.  
32 100, sect. 13.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$1,000.)

33 For printing and binding the annual reports of  
34 the bureau of statistics of labor, a sum not exceed-  
35 ing five thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 9;  
36 Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$4,000.)

37 For expenses in connection with the making of an-  
38 nual returns by cities and towns, a sum not exceeding  
39 forty-seven hundred dollars. [Acts 1906, chap. 296.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$6,000.)

40 For expenses in connection with the establishment  
41 and maintenance of free employment offices in this  
42 Commonwealth, a sum not exceeding twenty-five  
43 thousand dollars. [Acts 1906, chap. 435; 1907, chap.  
44 135.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$25,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
