### AN ACT

Relative to Fixing the Compensation of Employees of Poor Departments in Cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter eighty-one of the Revised Laws  
2 is hereby amended by inserting a new section to be num-  
3 bered section forty-five, as follows:— *Section 45.* Over-  
4 seers of the poor, in all cities of the Commonwealth, may  
5 in their discretion determine and fix the compensation  
6 of all persons employed or appointed by them in executing  
7 the pauper laws, such compensation to be approved by  
8 the mayor of the city, before it shall take effect.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
