Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph D. Goddu for legislation to provide that fruit, nuts and vegetables shall be sold by dry measure. Mercantile Affairs. January 14.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To provide that Fruit, Nuts and Vegetables shall be sold by Dry Measure.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-one of chapter fifty-seven
2 of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out
3 the words "if sold by measure," in line one, and by in-
4 serting after the word "measure," in line two, the words:
5 — *or legal weight*, — so as to read as follows:—

6 *Section 21.* All fruits, vegetables and nuts, shall be
7 sold by dry measure *or legal weight*, and whoever vio-
8 lates the provisions of this section shall forfeit not more
9 than ten dollars for each offence.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
